The Beer Board of Cumberland Gap Tennessee met in a special called session on March 30, 2015. Mayor McGaffee called for an alphabetical roll call of the Board Members. Board Members answered as follows: Susan Bain-absent; Chuck Coffey-here; Teresa Fuson-absent; Jerry Hopson -here; John Ravnum-here; Phillip Waller-here.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the off- premise consumption beer permit application submitted by Teresa Marie Blanton to operate “The Cumberland Gap Market” at 519 Lynn Street.

Ms. Blanton was asked the following questions:

Question: Have you ever been convicted any crimes? Answer: No (other than a speeding ticket)

Question: Have you ever been engaged in the buying or selling of alcoholic beverages?
Answer: No

Question: Have you ever worked in an establishment selling alcoholic beverages?
Answer: Yes

Question: Were you trained about the laws concerning minors & under age consumption?
Answer: Yes

Question: Are you familiar with the Tennessee laws concerning under age consumption, sales, and identification? Answer: Yes

Question: Are you renting the building? Answer: Yes

Question: Anyone else renting it with you? Answer: No

Question: You’re the sole tenant & the only one responsible for the rent? Answer: Yes

Question: You understand the requirements to pay your wholesalers & the beer tax involved to payment to them? Answer: Yes

Question: Have you had any contact to start that process? Answer: I have and was waiting on my tax ID, which finally came in.

Question: Do you intend to employ anyone? Answer: maybe in the future, but not in the next 4 to 5 months.

Question: What are your hours of operation? Answer: 9:00 am -6:00 pm until summer in which the hours will change to 9:00 am – 8:00 pm.

Question: When do you anticipate to open? Answer: April 12, 2015
