The Historic Zoning Commission met in regular session, on March 3, 2020 with the meeting being called to order at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall building, 330 Colwyn, Cumberland Gap, TN.

The Commission discussed getting planned renovation project's paperwork to the commission in a time that would allow the Commission to review the project. A motion to require the COA to be presented to the City Hall at least one week prior to the scheduled monthly meeting was made by Jerry Hopson and seconded by Tammy Debrot. All approved.

The plans for the Estep property were presented and discussed. The architect's drawings were shared with members of the commission. There was discussion of the design elements and potential uses for the site. The historic nature of the area needs to be maintained and will be part of the process as we proceed.

There were no citizen's comments.

There was a motion to adjourn made by Jerry Hopson and seconded Steve Moore. The meeting was adjourned.
