The Planning and Zoning Commission met in regular session on January 5, 2020 with the meeting being called to order at 6:00 pm at the Town Hall building, 330 Colwyn, Cumberland Gap, TN.

- 2. Insuring a quiet residential neighborhood.
- 3. Safety for all ages.
- 4. There would be a character shift of the neighborhood.
- 5. The value of the property as a true residential neighborhood would diminish.

There were no citizen comments.
