BEER BOARD MINUTES

The Beer Board of Cumberland Gap, Tennessee met in regular session on April 2, 2018, immediately following the Town Board meeting. Mayor Pucciarelli called for a roll call. Board Members answered as follows: Susan Bain-here; Chuck Coffey- here; Teresa Fuson- absent; Jerry Hopson -here; John Ravnum-here; Phillip Waller-here.

Mayor Pucciarelli called for approval of the minutes. Jerry Hopson made a motion to the approve minutes, with a second by Susan Bain. Mayor Pucciarelli called for a roll call vote. Mayor Pucciarelli called for Old Business:
There was no old business.

Mayor Pucciarelli called for New Business:

Blake Luck, the owner of the Pinnacle Pub, was present to address a rumor concerning his establishment. It was brought to his attention that an individual made a statement that they like to visit the Pinnacle Pub because underage drinking is allowed in the establishment. Mr. Luck assured the board that was not the case. All patrons are carded by the security guards at the door before they can enter. If they don't have identification they are not allowed to enter and only certain forms of identification are accepted. A black light among other security measures are used to detect fakes. Underage patrons are allowed to enter but are identified by a color coded wrist band and are not allowed to drink. The color of the wristband changes so it cannot be reused.

He told the board that he plans to contact the Alcoholic Beverage Commission (ABC) about visiting his establishment. If someone uses a fake ID and manages to slip by his security then they will go to jail.
